## ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN 4 - ASLIHAN ŞENEL

**RULE ONE:** Find a place you trust, and then try trusting it for awhile. [But do not trust anything %100. Also be boldly and creatively critical.]

**RULE TWO:** General duties of a student - pull everything out of your teacher; pull everything out of your fellow students.

**RULE THREE:** General duties of a teacher - pull everything out of your students.

RULE FOUR: Consider everything an experiment.

**RULE FIVE:** Be self-disciplined – this means finding someone wise or smart and choosing to follow them. To be disciplined is to follow in a good way. To be self-disciplined is to follow in a better way.

**RULE SIX:** Nothing is a mistake. There's no win and no fail, there's only make.

**RULE SEVEN:** The only rule is work. If you work it will lead to something. It's the people who do all of the work all of the time who eventually catch on to things.

**RULE EIGHT:** Don't try to create and analyze at the same time. They're different processes.

**RULE NINE:** Be happy whenever you can manage it. Enjoy yourself. It's lighter than you think. [But if you feel down, use it as a driving force to work. Unhappiness is also a productive mood, as you wouldn't expect]

**RULE TEN:** We're breaking all the rules. Even our own rules. And how do we do that? By leaving plenty of room for X quantities.

**HELPFUL HINTS:** Always be around. Come or go to everything. Always go to [the studio]. Read anything you can get your hands on. Look at movies carefully, often. Save everything — it might come in handy later. [Advice: Try to involve into different activities, wether it is related with your studies or not, nothing is irrelevant.]

[RULE ELEVEN: Get help, give help, enjoy working together. Bir elin nesi var, iki elin sesi var. Two heads are better than one. Do not think you may know everthing. Don't always talk, but learn to listen.

**RULE TWELVE:** Love provides a space of attraction beyond language (of words, drawing, ...), love the work you do, love your colleagues, love the studio in order to start working in the first instance. Choose those ones you' d love.

**RULE THIRTEEN:** Keep communication on, show your work to others to improve its communicability.

**AN ADVICE:** We - students, tutors - are all human, with mistakes and feelings. Do not judge, just communicate and enjoy! ]
